- 2. Lions, Tigers, and Alignment (Amy Thach) ORPIE is able to create many reports since GWC moved from TracDat to Nuventive. This year the focus is to ensure SLOs align with PLOs and iSLOs; identify gaps in curriculum. Amy is reaching out to all departments for this project that needs to be completed by the end of Fall 2024.
- 3. CCN and TMCs All of the ADTs and CCN need to be updated by the end of the Fall 2024 semester. Departments that are in phase 1 of the CCN are impacting the ADTs so please submit the course revision reflecting CCN. The Chancellor's Office released new TMCs (CSU GE and IGETC removed; Cal-GETC included), GWC needs to complete these. Faculty have been emailed with three options to select from in order to help faculty with the new TMCs. Faculty will have the opportunity to review their curriculum with all three options.

- Option 1: Departments submit the program revision and attach all supporting documents in Curricunet (TMC, narrative, etc.).
- Option 2: The Articulation Officer and Curriculum Specialist will complete the TMC, narrative, and supporting
 documents. These documents will be provided to the department faculty to review and enter into
 Curricunet.
- Option 3: The Articulation Officer and Curriculum Specialist will send discipline faculty the completed TMC for approval. All program revisions will be entered into Curricunet on the department's behalf.

Associate degrees and certificate of achievements that are impacted by CCN are responsible for generating the program revision. The deadline for all is October 21st in order to be on the October 22nd technical review agenda. Damien Jordan may have a program sequence plan for Chairs & Deans Department committee. Charissa and Nicole will be completing TMCs for departments who select option 2 and 3. The goal is to consider these for consent being that the changes are minimal. Revisions will be evaluated for placement on the agenda. If programs are only changing back end documents then nothing forward facing is changing (catalog description and PLOs) then move straight to level 7 curriculum in the workflow, major revisions may need two readings.
