- 3. Guided Pathways Presentation by Matt Valerius:
 - a. Area 1: This report will be submitted to the state on progress of Guided Pathways. Area 1 describes programs that have been organized into meta majors. Counseling has worked with all programs to further clarify each meta major. Work has been done to align math courses to go with the correct major. Describes activities and progress of said activity and any barriers to implementation of each thereof.
 - b. Area 2: Covers helping students transition from high school to college to pathway of choice. Student prep via different support services i.e., Academic success center, math lab, embedded tutoring. Get rid of remedial course work and replace it with transfer level courses with added supplemental support. Noncredit ELL and Early College Academy and expanded dual enrollment are also noteworthy accomplishments.
 - c. Area 3: Covers keeping students on path-persistence and retention. This includes cAMP, auto awarding program, degrees when due, counselors early alert-track students and food distribution.
 - d. Area 4: Covers measurements of student learning. This includes SLO's, internships and co-ops.
