3/15/21- DCC Notes- From Dorsie:

- Going to get super busy
 - Head down keep going- pandemic fatigue is real, but need to keep things going and safe.
- BPAP- very active- hiring committees have been revised or almost revised
 - Legal opinion from Chancellor's office about video camera- Generally, in most faculty should be okay with no video, but if they are going to require it, it needs to be clear in the syllabus and up front in the class. 4105- DE- revised it to add language related to video.
- Tech committee-
 - Update for registration will force the choice of a college- Ready in June
 - Zoom recording Contradictory language in
 - June 7- Zoom Pro District Accounts- 6 months limit on zoom recording
 - Starting trainings before June
 - Microsoft full computer downloads, for those PT faculty who have a need.
- Budget
 - o American Rescue Plan- Seen different figures, but we should receive 50m to the colleges
 - 51% goes to direct student aid
 - Maintenance of effort for the state- state has to keep funding the colleges at the same levels
 - One time resources
 - District has gotten indirect costs for the federal rescue dollars- NOT the direct aid to students, but that will help with the bottom line. (Percentage of the whole that helps support the "indirect costs" for the college.) Don't need to justify how we spend that portion to the granting agency.
- Strategic Plan
 - Filled in- looking for feedback- going to be mailed to DCC and will request feedback.
 - DCC committee do a deep dive before next meeting.
 - Feedback from constituencies- by end of May
- Post Pandemic Response
 - Vaccinations- Make sure that your Othena profile says education- also information on how to find pharmacies that have appointments.

 - Prevention Plan for COVID
 - Return to campus plans
