 - **a.** The SEAP Team provided a presentation on the Equity Special Funding Proposal process; PPT from the SEAP Team will be uploaded to the CS MS Teams Site, and the meeting was recorded for those who weren't present.

6. President/Chancellor Update

a. President -

- i. Setting up website for all committee communications to be housed. (Since SharePoint is broken)
 - 1. Diana Retes & Marketing/Graphics are creating new landing site on the public GWC website
 - a. Will also create a public site for the Classified Senate
- ii. Outcomes from the Spring Retreat -
 - 1. Creating two taskforces
 - **a.** Strategic Planning led by Meridith
 - **b.** Committee Structure Co-Chaired by AS and CS
 - 2. Master plan almost done needs sign off from AS, CS, and PB
 - **a.** According to President McGrath, Master Plan is a "snap shot in time" so won't be updated even though it's already out of date
 - **3.** Shift in tone/culture for students to have more active/legitimate voice in our governance processes campus-wide
 - **a.** Idea to appoint student to CS potentially for Fall 2021 semester
- **b.** Chancellor
 - i. Working from home after COVID Talk about equity for employees i.e., Sick with a cold, sick child/parent possibility to work at home in these scenarios
 - Chancellor was receptive to the idea, but there is also the reality that this a) is a bargaining issue and b) he encouraged all three CS Presidents to keep advocating for these changes in larger venues (Planning and Budget, College Council, etc.)
 - ii. Free College for All
 - 1. Chancellor was supportive of the idea, but with the caveat that it would depend on details of policy (I.e., is this a funded effort, etc.)
 - 2. Townsend Public Affairs advocacy/lobbying group for District
 - iii. Budget Is there a consistent message?
 - Nope Vice Chancellor Andy Dunn has more conservative/pessimistic view, CFCE has more liberal/optimistic view; Chancellor is somewhere in between the two views
