Meeting the minimum eligibility requirements does not guarantee admission. All complete applications submitted by the filing deadline are scored. Qualified applicants are randomly ranked from highest to lowest points. Students with the highest points are selected. Lottery selection will be awarded to a number of qualified applicants. A limited number of alternate applicants are also selected.
